

Preplacement Lessons Writing Team

Scope:

The Ontario Cooperative Education Association (OCEA) is seeking a curriculum writing team to create preplacement lessons as an update to the OCEA document: "Pre-placement and Integration Curriculum (PIC) Resource for Cooperative Education and other forms of Experiential Learning." There are 6 positions available.

You are invited to apply for a position on a writing team that will support the development of cooperative education resources as it pertains to school, the workplace and community.

The members of the team would curate up-to-date resources. The ideal end result will be to create interactive and visually appealing slide decks for preplacement activities.

Context:

Cooperative education provides students in all pathways - apprenticeship, college, community living, university, or the workplace, with experiential learning opportunities which promote personal growth, career exploration and employability skill development. Through the cooperative education program students will:

- ★ Gain workplace experience in a unique learning environment outside the classroom.
- ★ Develop employability skills and work habits that are applicable to the workplace.
- ★ Participate in hands-on learning in a safe and encouraging environment.
- ★ Choose a work placement based on their interests, readiness and needs.
- ★ Connect and build relationships with potential future employers.

2 Cooperative Education Teachers writing and sourcing information in English

2 Cooperative Education Teachers writing and sourcing information in French

2 Tech Savvy Teachers to create creative, aesthetically pleasing, interactive slide decks using information from the team
